STRUCTURE	LANGUAGE	TO BE AVOIDED
<p>A clear structure comprising:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an introduction with a concise statement of the student's opinion • the main part: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • appropriate paragraphing • quotation and paraphrasing, where appropriate • the inclusion of ideas to illustrate arguments in the main part; this might be factual, logical, statistical or anecdotal evidence • a conclusion emphasising the student's opinion in the light of the ideas in the main part 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • compound sentences: infinite forms, apposition, non-defining relative clauses, conditional clauses etc. • sparing use of incomplete sentences (e.g. <i>Which can be a problem.</i>) may be appropriate • clear and logical transitions between the different parts: connectors such as <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>In view of ...</i>, • <i>That's why ...</i>, • <i>therefore ...</i>, • <i>As a result</i> • <i>..., which means that ...</i> • the first-person pronoun is appropriate; a clear point of view is required <p>Register (formal, neutral, informal) depending on the target audience as defined in the task</p>	<p>Do not</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • include excessive detail on the source and publication of the input text • copy from the input text or include lengthy and unnecessary quotes • add new ideas in the conclusion
